Teachers should consider any potential applicants carefully as to their financial status, and for whom continuing lessons would be a severe strain or impossible without aid. Such students should also show musical potential, dedication to their instrument, enthusiastic performance and attitude, and display above average work.

A student receiving tuition assistance is required to participate in two different performance events, outside of the teacher's own studio, during the academic year for which the student is being funded. See the Guidelines for specific requirements and examples of appropriate events. Brief reports on progress and participation are also requested of the teacher midyear, and of the student at the end of the year.
