WMC gives members many opportunities to be involved with our Club's activities and mission. Please see descriptions below. It's a great way to meet new people and participate in our dynamic group. STANDING COMMITTEES AND MISSION-DRIVEN PROGRAMS:

Competition: The Competition (Jan. or Feb.) and Winners Recital (March) are highlights of our year requiring many hands to achieve the best possible results. Several sub-committees work together to assist with reviewing the previous year's efforts and procedures, scheduling judges and volunteers, making area teachers aware of the competition and the community aware of the Recital as well as sending notes of appreciation.

Development: Help identify prospective donors and direct the fund-raising efforts of WMC.

Finance: Assist the chair and the Club's professional treasurer in formulating a budget to be presented for approval by the WMC Board at its June meeting and also provides oversight for long-range planning.
